

Heritage Music Instrument Rental Scheme

The Heritage Music Instrument Rental Scheme is designed specifically to be straightforward, flexible and affordable. It is not a Hire-Purchase agreement, but rather a hire-to-buy which is a much more flexible arrangement. Parents can rent the instrument for as long as they wish (which some choose to do for various reasons) and if the pupil gives up playing, the instrument is simply returned to us.

However, should you want to actually buy the instrument, or upgrade and buy a better model, ***the first eight months rental is deducted from the initial agreed price.*** Please read the conditions carefully and fill in the information as required if you wish to continue.

Terms and conditions

- 1) The minimum rental period is three (3) months and thereafter one (1) months notice is required to terminate this agreement.
- 2) After eight months (8) you have the option to buy the instrument at the residual price quoted – we will contact you at that point.
- 3) The instrument can be hired for as long as required, but only 8 months of the hire fees may be deducted off the price in event of purchase.
- 4) The instrument remains the property of HERITAGE MUSIC whilst it is on hire and normal maintenance (outside normal wear and tear) is free. Strings, valve oil, reeds and rosin are consumables and not covered under wear and tear.
- 5) Repairs required due to mishandling or accident, or lost instruments will be charged to the hirers account. This includes rectifying badly carried out repairs by a third party.
- 6) The hirer is responsible to make sure the instrument is returned to HERITAGE MUSIC in good working order. We can arrange this for you or you can use your preferred method. Instruments are returned at the hirer's expense.
- 7) Please ensure goods are appropriately packaged to be transported by carrier as the goods remain your responsibility until we have them in good order. Please also retain the signed proof of return from the Royal Mail or Carrier.
- 8) An instrument left at school when no longer required does not terminate the contract.
- 9) HERITAGE MUSIC does not insure the instrument and we strongly recommend that you obtain insurance against loss or damage.
- 10) It is a condition of the hire agreement that payment is made by Direct Debit.
- 11) It is a condition of Rental that proof of address (eg a utility bill) is supplied along with this signed rental agreement form.
